#### What are EasyCataract<sup>™</sup> Drops?

• Your doctor has prescribed a specially compounded formula of eye drops called EasyCataract<sup>TM</sup> that combines 3 different medications into one. This combination will make things more convenient than traditional therapies. Rather than juggling 3 different bottles following 3 different schedules, EasyCataract<sup>TM</sup> is one bottle with one schedule.

#### How much do the EasyCataract<sup>™</sup> Drops cost?

• EasyCataract<sup>TM</sup> Drops cost \$75 and will last long enough to cover surgeries of the right and left eye. You will receive 2 bottles, one for each eye. If you are only having one eye done, the cost is \$50. You will receive 1 bottle for one eye. The average patient will save about \$100 by not having to purchase 3 different bottles of drops. Also, approximately \$400-500 will not be charged to the insurance plan, perhaps helping to avoid the 'donut hole'.

#### How will it be sent? Are there special storage requirements?

We send all orders approximately 14 days prior to your first surgery. Refrigeration is not required.
 EasyCataract<sup>™</sup> are good for 90 days from their date of creation. Their "best use date" will be on the side of the dropper bottle.

#### Why are the EasyCataract<sup>™</sup> not covered by my insurance?

Your doctor wants the best outcome for you, so they have prescribed EasyCataract<sup>™</sup>.
 Unfortunately, Medicare and most insurance companies do not cover compounded medication.

#### What should I expect when my package arrives?

When your package arrives you will receive your drops, either one bottle or two. You will also
receive a kit containing a pair of protective sunglasses and a plastic eye shield with paper tape.
These will be used after your surgery.
